

A message from the...Utility Rates Review Council (URRC)

The URRC has received a request from Qulliq Energy Corporation (QEC) for a 1.35 cents per kWh fuel stabilization rider, effective from October 1, 2024, through March 31, 2025. The Minister responsible for Qulliq Energy Corporation forwarded the request to the URRC on October 4, 2024, for review and recommendation. In the interest of minimizing further rate increases and to comply with the parameters established for the Fuel Stabilization Rate Fund, the URRC recommended the rider be approved on an interim basis pending a full review to be completed by January 2, 2025. QEC fuel stabilization riders are automatically applied to monthly power bills and customers do not need to fill out an application form.

Written submissions regarding the fuel stabilization rider can be made to the URRC.
