Inunnguinig Coordinator

Location: Igaluit, Nunavut

Qaujigiartiit Health Research Centre is hiring an Inunnguiniq Coordinator to support the delivery of culturally grounded community programs across Nunavut. Inunnguiniq means "the process of making capable human beings" and is a central concept in Inuit ways of teaching and raising children.

The Inunnguiniq Coordinator will work with Elders, youth, and families to coordinate workshops, land-based programming, and community wellness initiatives grounded in Inuit knowledge. The role includes travel within Nunavut, coordination of training, and working closely with project teams and community partners.

Qualifications include:

- · Strong knowledge of Inuit culture and values
- · Experience working with community-based programs
- · Excellent communication and organizational skills
- · Must have lived in Nunavut for at least 3 years
- Inuktitut is a strong asset
- · A criminal record check will be required
