ELDERS PROGRAM MANAGER

Reporting to the Executive Director-Pairijiit Tigumiaktikkut, the **Elder Program Manager** will assist in the operation of the Elders Programming at the Elders Qarmaq in Iqaluit, Nunavut.

Obligations for weekend, call-out in an emergency or for events and/or meetings may be set in non-conventional working hours and may mean working on some statutory holidays without additional compensation.

Job Duties:

- Lead the development and planning of programs and activities for elders.
- Assist in the supervision and or participate in the society's programs.
- Assist the executive director with the finances, fundraising and administration as required.
- Assist with minutes and preparation of meetings of the board of Pairijiit, including set up of venues, translators and interpreters and guests, when necessary.
- Assist the cook, when necessary, in preparing the lunch program. Supervise with menu selections with the cook and ensure recipe ingredients are stocked ahead of time.
- Ensure elder assistant staff are doing their jobs such as cleaning of the Elder's Qarmaq.
- Ensure elder assistant staff have the elders' recreational needs such as bingo on Wednesdays.
- Plan, implement and evaluate recreation services for all members.

Requirements:

- Must have a sincere interest in people, the elderly in particular, and possess a genuine sensitivity to their needs.
- A knowledge of finances, administrative skills and minutetaking.

Assets:

- Ability to speak Inuktitut and have Inuit cultural knowledge
- Experience working with elderly adults.
