The Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) is seeking a suitable candidate to nominate as its chairperson.

The NWMB is the main instrument of wildlife management and the main regulator of access to wildlife in Nunavut, subject to the ultimate jurisdiction of the relevant responsible government minister. It fulfills this mandate by addressing its various functions under the Nunavut Agreement including those in Article 5 (Wildlife) and Article 15 (Marine Areas).

The NWMB's mission is managing wildlife, guided by conservation principles, honouring the key role of Inuit in harvesting, for the well-being of current and future generations in Nunavut. The NWMB also administers the Nunavut Wildlife Research Trust, where the NWMB Chairperson serves as a trustee.

The NWMB Chairperson presides over meetings and hearings of the NWMB, both in person and virtually. The Chairperson is appointed for a four-year term. The NWMB submits its nomination for Chairperson to the Governor in Council. In carrying out this role, the Chairperson must adhere to and apply NWMB policies, procedures, programs, and decisions.

The desired candidate for this position should:

- Be familiar with Inuit rights under the Nunavut Agreement
- Understand wildlife management practices in Nunavut
- Have experience chairing meetings
- Have a basic knowledge of Article 5 (Wildlife) of the Nunavut Agreement
- Be a strong communicator
- Be able to use computer technology such as tablets and electronic documents
- Ability to speak both Inuktitut and English is an asset

This position requires travel. Preference will be given to individuals residing in Nunavut.
